



Consent for Psychological Evaluation

I, _____ agree to undergo psychological evaluation administered by the Claret Center. (hereafter referred to as Claret) and I understand that Claret has assigned Mary Worden, PsyD, a psychologist, to conduct the testing, to write the testing report, and to present the results of the testing. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, I agree to undergo the testing via secure telehealth to promote safety and social distancing.

I have read, understood and agreed to the following statement as the conditions under which I have given this consent. I also understand that with written notice, I can revoke this consent at any time.

I understand that the testing process involves the completion of a variety of psychological assessment instruments and personal interviews. The total time of the evaluation may vary and will depend upon the questions I or the referral source who made the testing referral might have. I understand that I may experience emotional distress because of the personal nature of some of the information solicited by the testing process. I may interrupt or discontinue this testing process at any time.

After the testing process is completed, a report based on the results of the testing and information provided by me and others will be written. Unless I indicate otherwise in writing to the psychologist who administered the testing, this report will be given to the person or agency who referred me for this service and a copy of this report will be kept in the testing subject's treatment record at Claret. An appointment with the psychologist who performed the testing will be scheduled to discuss the results of the psychological testing, unless feedback is provided on the day of testing.

Limits of Confidentiality: Like all treatment records, reports and results of psychological testing are confidential and can be released only with a written consent authorizing such release. However, I understand if I disclose information related to suspected threats of physical harm of self or others, occurrence of child, elder, or dependent adult abuse, or if commanded by court order, Claret will be required to disclose such information to appropriate authorities or parties mandated by law.
